PAPER ANIMALS

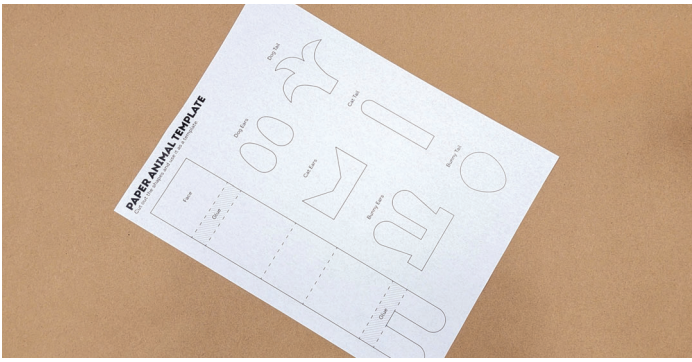
WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Non-toxic glue

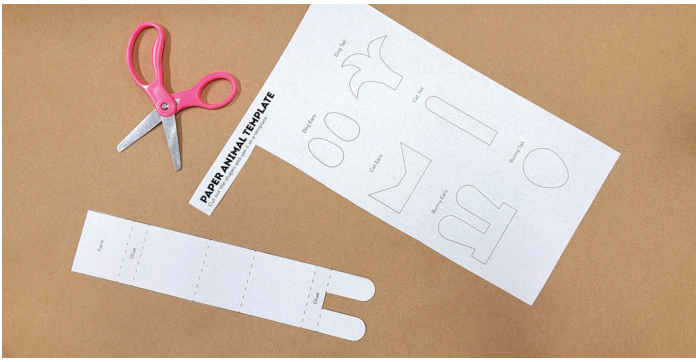

1. Print the paper animal template provided with the activities for home (page 4).



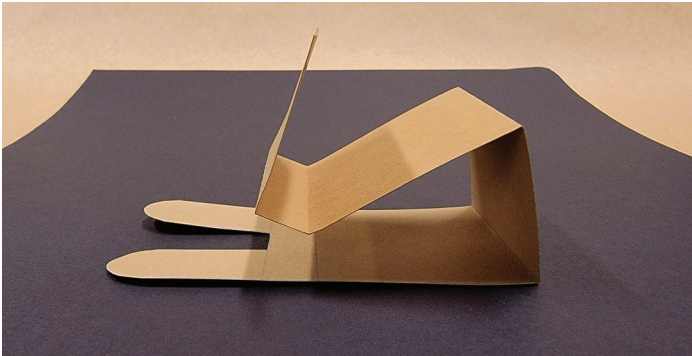
2. Cut out the shapes from the template.



3. Trace the template shapes over construction paper.



4. Cut out the shapes from the construction paper.



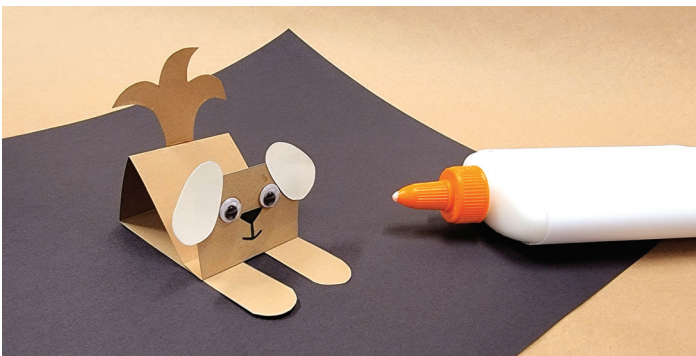
5. Fold the body pieces as shown in the image above.



6. Draw on the paper dog's face. Glue on the googly eyes and ears.



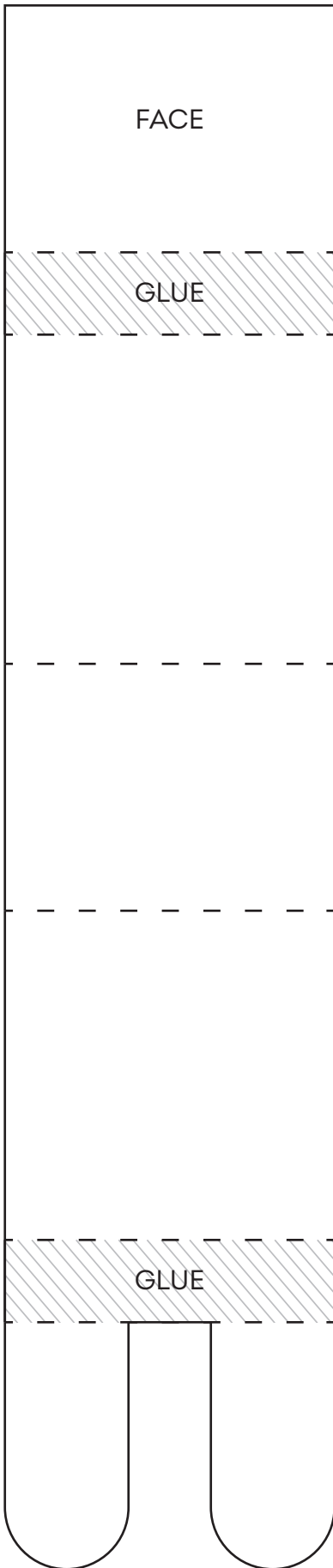
7. Look for the areas on the template that specify 'glue' and glue them together.



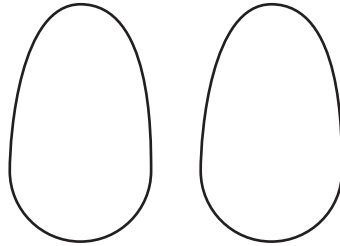
8. Glue the tail piece to the back of your paper animal.

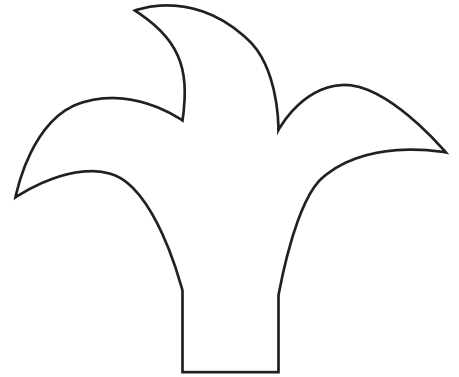

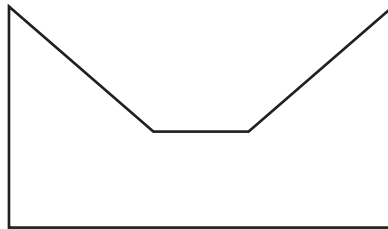

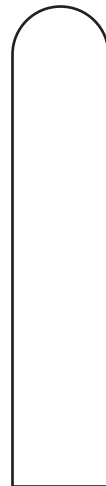
DOG TAIL



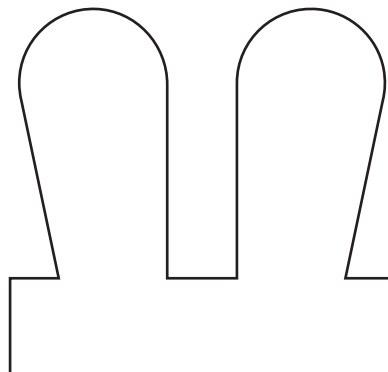
CAT EARS



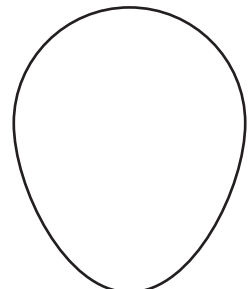
CAT TAIL

PET HOUSE

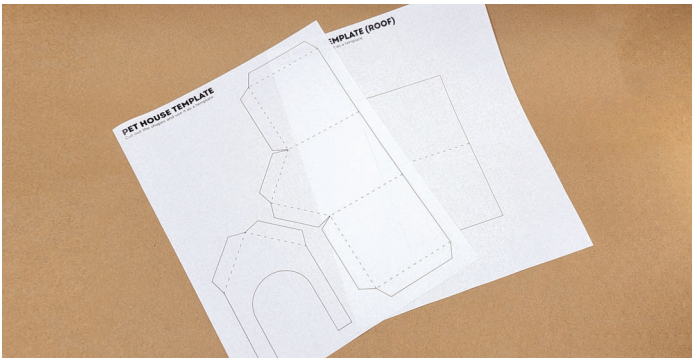
WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Construction paper
- Non-toxic glue
- Washi tape
- Safety scissors
- Pet house templates
- Pencil

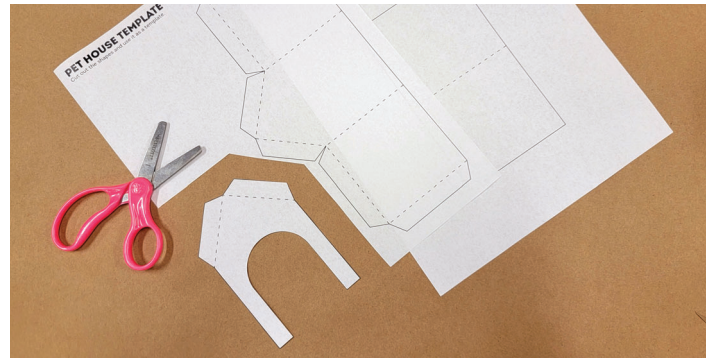

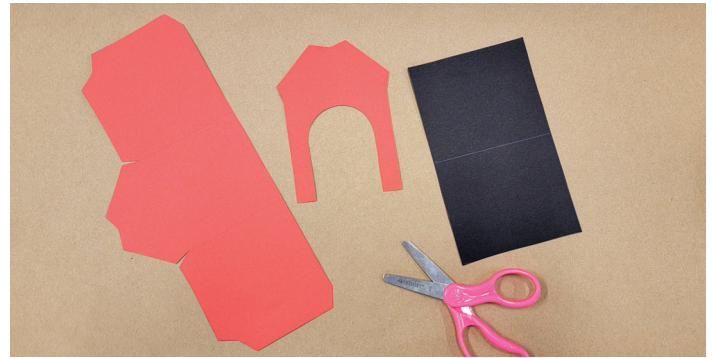
1. Print the pet house template provided with the activities for home (Pages 7 and 8).



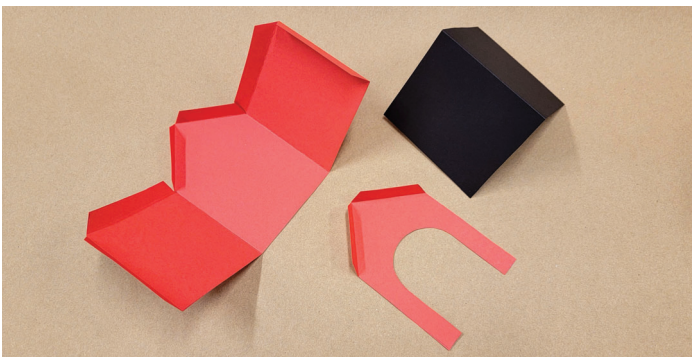
2. Cut out the template shapes.



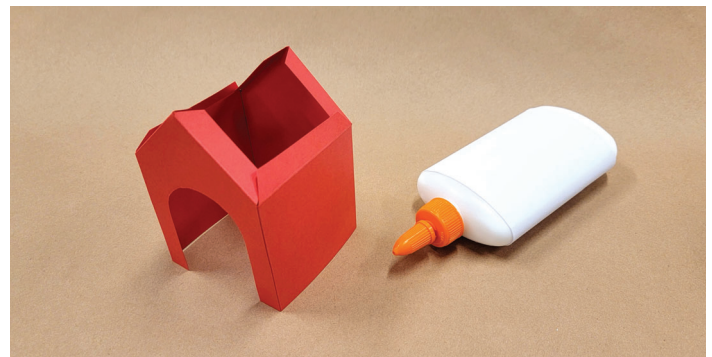
3. Trace the template shapes over construction paper.



4. Cut the traced shapes out.



5. Fold up the flaps as specified on the template.



6. Glue the door piece and walls together at the flaps.



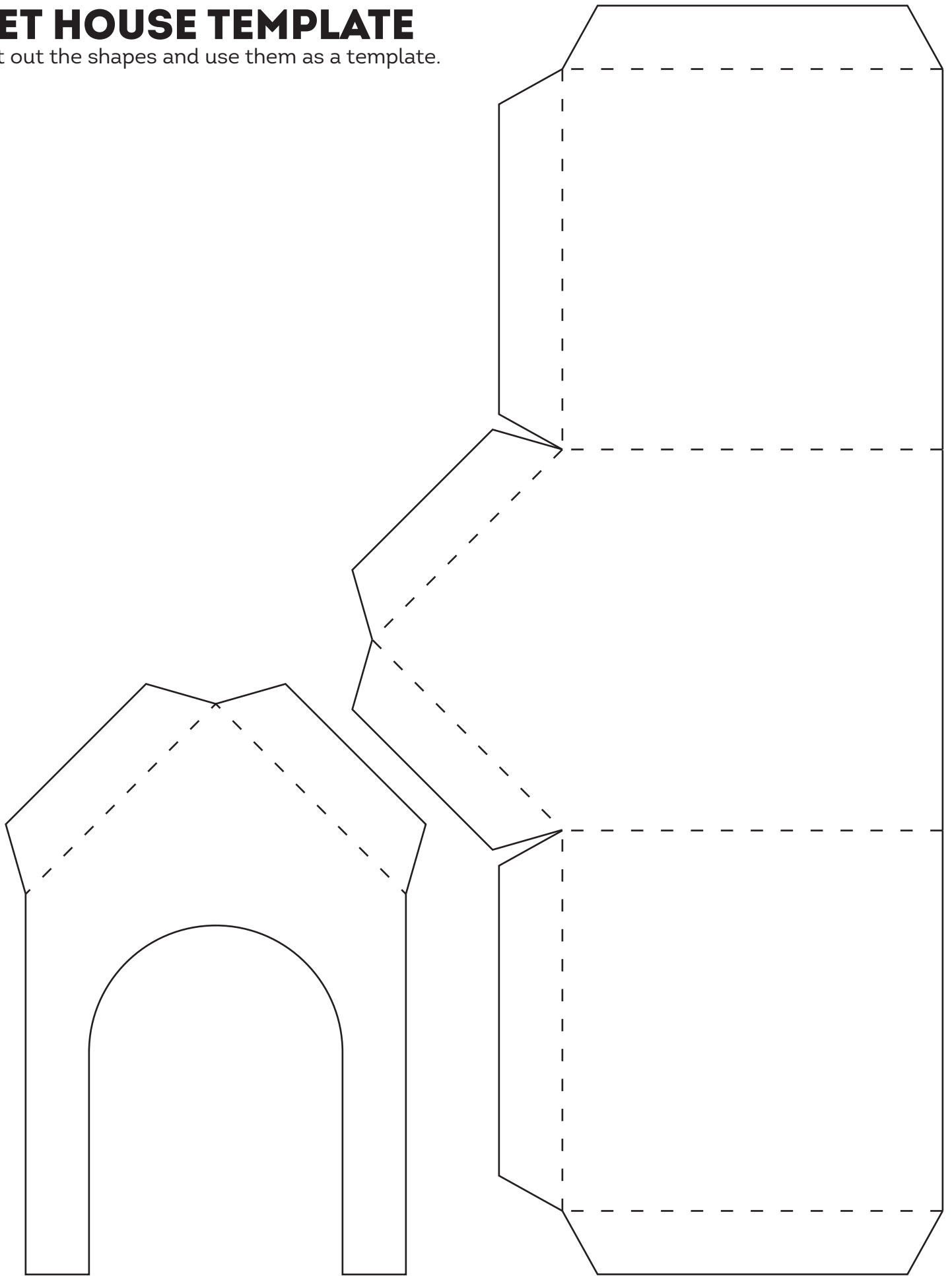
7. Glue on the roof, securing it on the top flaps.



8. Decorate the house with washi tape and different shapes cut out of construction paper.

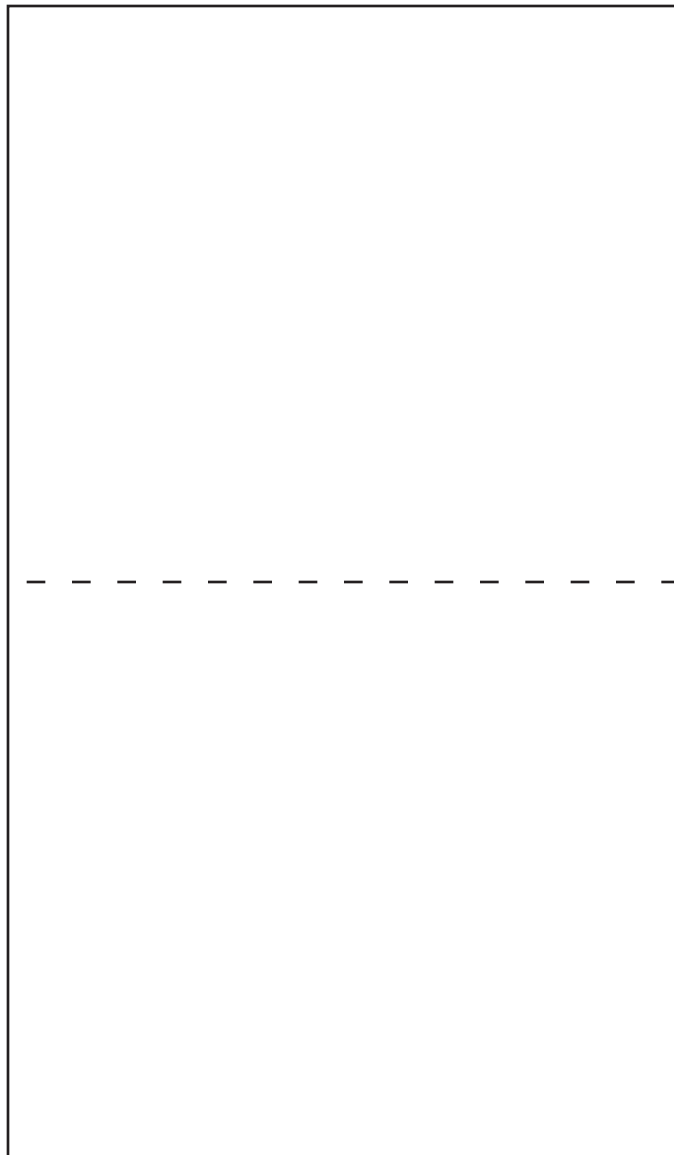
PET HOUSE TEMPLATE

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

FELT ANIMALS

- Felt fabric
- Safety scissors
- Non-toxic glue
- Felt animal template
- Non-toxic marker

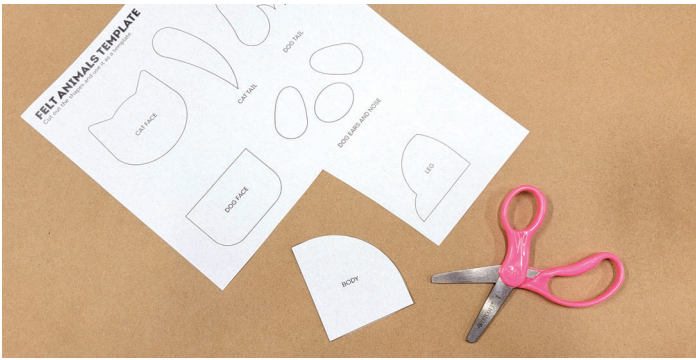

1. Print the felt animal template provided with the activities for home (page 12).



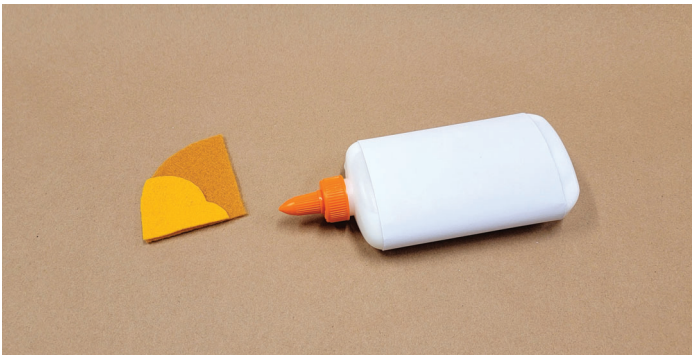
2. Cut out the shapes from the template.



3. Trace the felt animal template shapes with a marker on felt fabric.



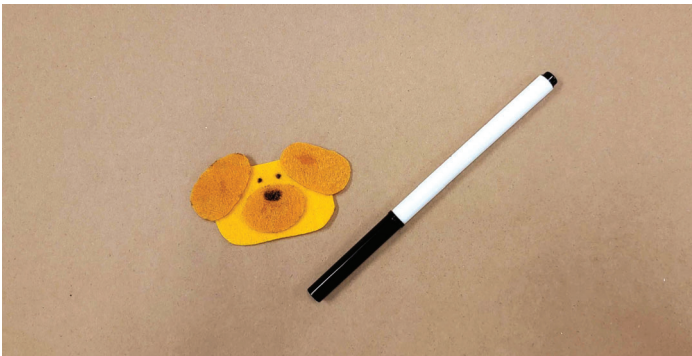
4. Cut out the traced shapes.



5. Glue the leg to the body.



6. Glue the ears and mouth to the face.



7. Draw on the animal's eyes and nose with a marker.



8. Glue the head to the body.



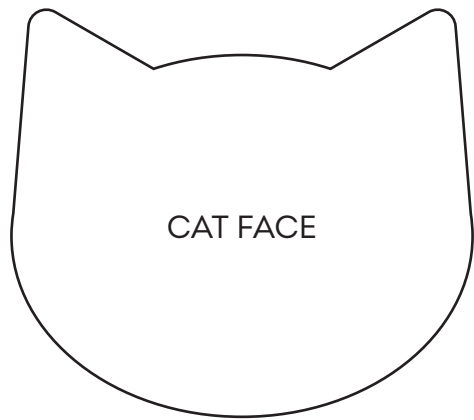
9. Turn it over and glue the tail to the body.



10. Turn it back over and your felt animal is done!

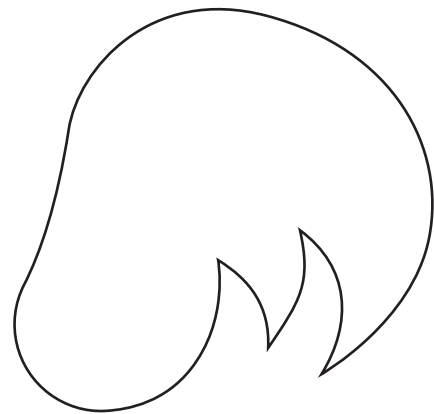

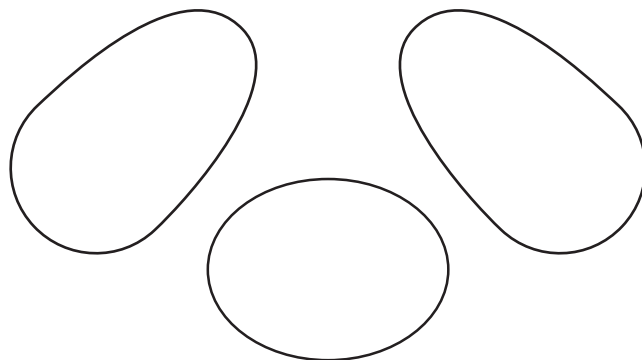
CAT TAIL



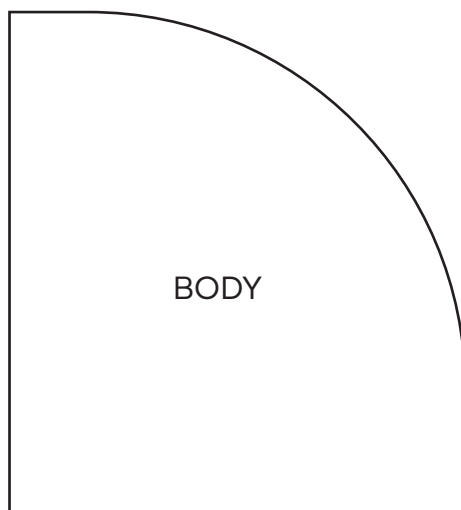

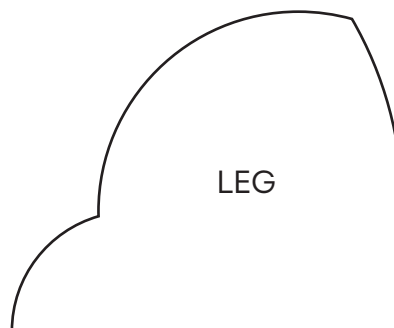
