

# **ACTIVITIES FOR HOME**



CRAFT SAFETY: Adult supervision is required for any arts & crafts project. Observe children closely and intervene as needed to prevent potential safety problems and ensure appropriate use of materials. Some craft items are potential choking hazards for young children. Avoid use of small parts with children ages 3 or younger. Read all manufacturers' warnings before using arts & crafts supplies.





# MOOD BRACELET

#### WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Mood bracelet templateSafety scissors
- Non-toxic markers
- Construction paper
- Pencil

CAUTION: The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling. Adult use of safety scissors recommended for children 3 years or younger.





1. Print out the mood bracelet template.




2. Cut out the pieces on the template.



3. Trace the template onto construction paper.



4. Cut out the traced shape from the construction paper, and add slits into the band and face as specified on the template.



5. Use markers to draw expressions on the band. Draw accents on the face shape.




 Insert the band through the slits from the back. (Cut additional slits if the bracelet is too large.) Ask a parent to help you close the bracelet over your wrist.

### CRAFT STICK FRIENDS

#### WHAT YOU'LL NEED:


- Safety scissors
- Non-toxic glue
- Construction paper 
  Non-toxic markers
- Pencil
- Craft stick
- Pipe cleaners
- Googly eyes

CAUTION: The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling. Adult use of safety scissors recommended for children 3 years or younger.





1. Use small craft sticks for the stick friend body.



2. Color the craft stick with a brown marker.



3. Sketch an animal head onto a piece of construction paper.



5. Decorate the animal head with googly eyes and draw on a face with a marker.



7. Wrap pipe cleaner around the craft stick to create a body and arms for your stick friend.



4. Cut out the sketched animal head.



6. Glue the animal head to the stick.



## WASHI TAPE BRACELET

#### WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Safety scissors
- Paper roll
- Washi tape

CAUTION: The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling. Adult use of safety scissors recommended for children 3 years or younger.





1. Cut a paper roll to a smaller size.



2. Cut a slit into the paper roll.



3. Cut the paper roll in smaller sections.



4. Cover the paper roll bracelet with washi tape.



5. Add accents with a different color of washi tape.



6. Create multiple designs with different colored washi tape.
