ACTIVITIES FOR HOME



CRAFT SAFETY: Adult supervision is required for any arts & crafts project. Observe children closely and intervene as needed to prevent potential safety problems and ensure appropriate use of materials. Some craft items are potential choking hazards for young children. Avoid use of small parts with children ages 3 or younger. Read all manufacturers' warnings before using arts & crafts supplies.



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CAR WASH

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Safety scissors
- Non-toxic glue
- Washi tape
- Non-toxic marker
- Cardboard box
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Tissue paper



CAUTION: The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling.





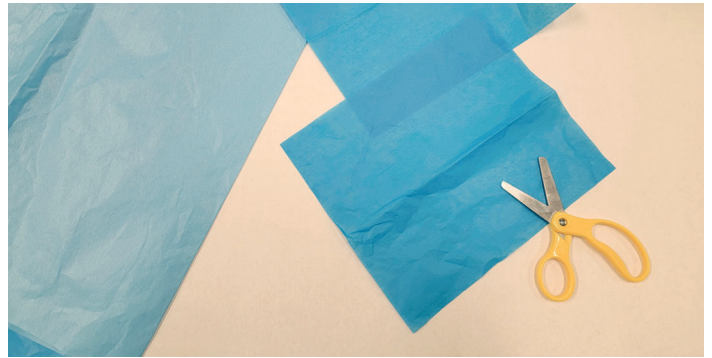
1. Use a cardboard box and cut off the flaps on each side of the box.



2. Draw a 5- by 6-inch rectangle on the shorter side of the cardboard box.



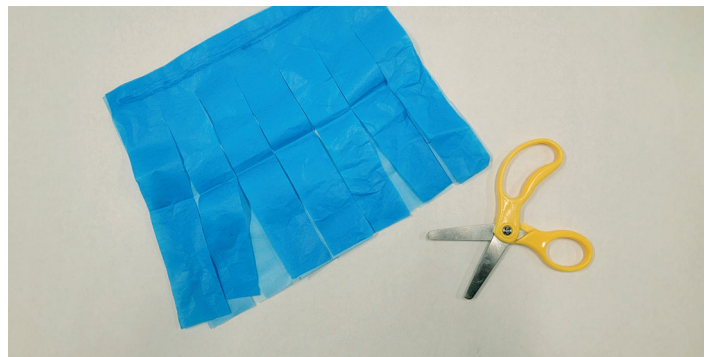
3. Cut the rectangle out of the cardboard box. Do this for the other side of the cardboard box as well.



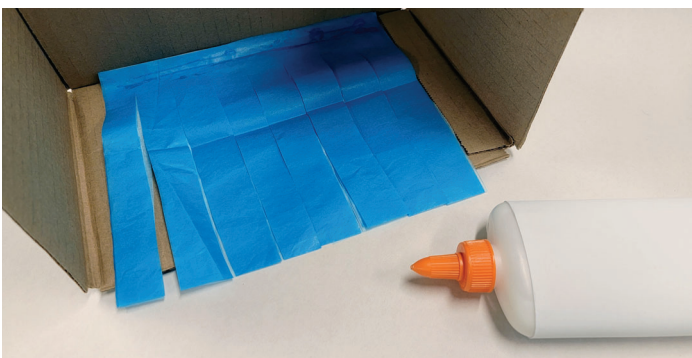
4. Cut three 5- by 6.5-inch rectangles out of blue tissue paper. Use different hues of blue.



5. Overlay the rectangles and glue them together along one of the shorter edges.



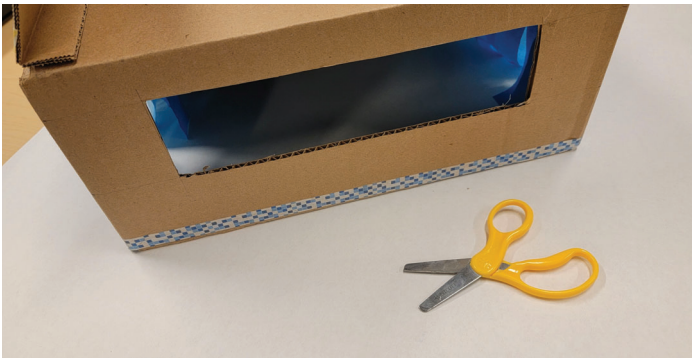
6. After the glue has dried, cut approximately 1-inch-wide strips up to the glued area.



7. Glue the uncut side of the tissue paper curtain to the top of the entrance. Repeat steps 4, 5, 6, and 7 for the other opening you cut out.



8. Lay the box on its longer side and draw on a 9- by 3-inch rectangle.



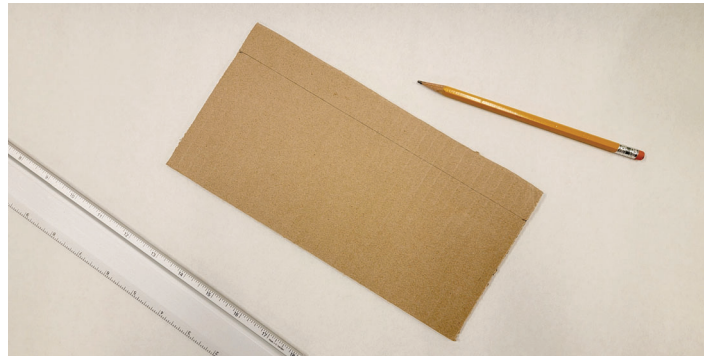
9. Cut out the rectangle to create a window for your car wash.



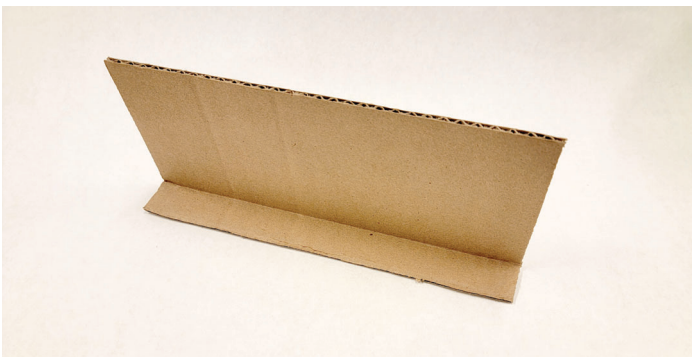
10. Flip your cardboard box around and draw something on it that represents your car wash.



11. Trace it with a marker.



12. Use the short flaps that you cut off the cardboard box in step 1, and draw a line one inch away from the edge of the cardboard.



13. Fold the cardboard along the line that you drew.



14. Sketch out the car wash entrance sign.



15. Trace your sketch with markers.



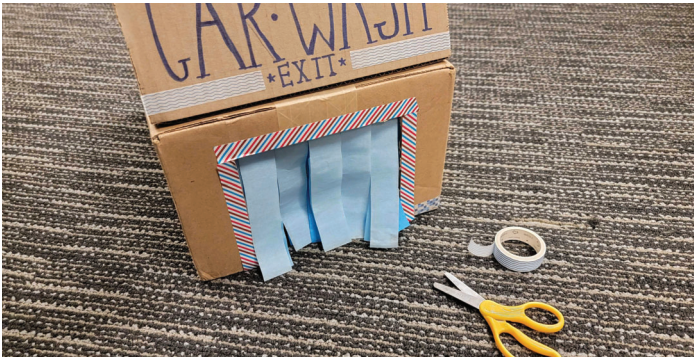
16. Repeat steps 12, 13, 14 and 15 for the exit sign.



17. Glue the sign above your car wash.



18. Decorate the outside of your car wash with different patterns of washi tape.



19. Do the same for the exit.



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DIY ROADS WITH CARDBOARD BRIDGE

WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Safety scissors
- Pencil
- Non-toxic glue
- Cardboard
- Non-toxic paint (black and white)
- Road corner template
- Paper roll
- Ruler



CAUTION: The cutting edges of scissors are sharp, and care should be taken whenever cutting or handling.

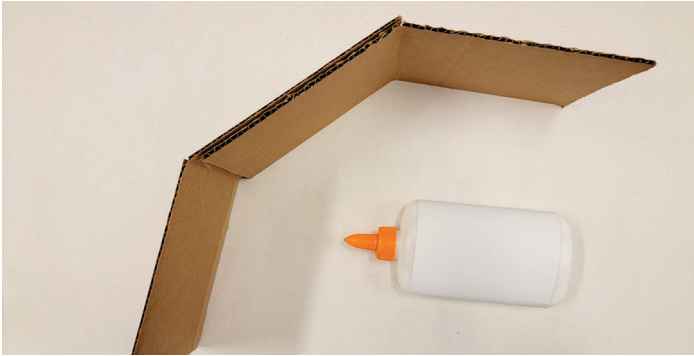




1. Measure a 5- by 7-inch cardboard rectangle and cut it out.



2. Cut out two 5- by 14-inch rectangles.



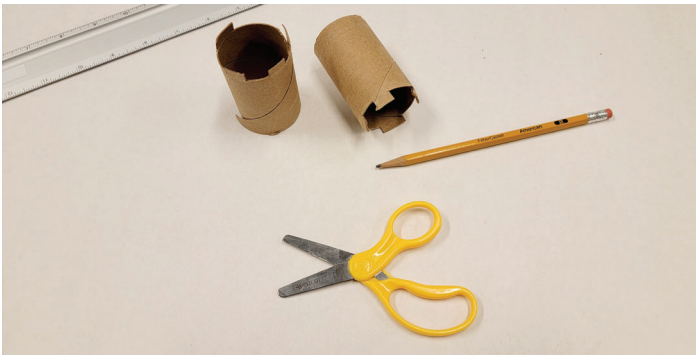
3. Fold the 5- by 14-inch in half and glue them together as shown.



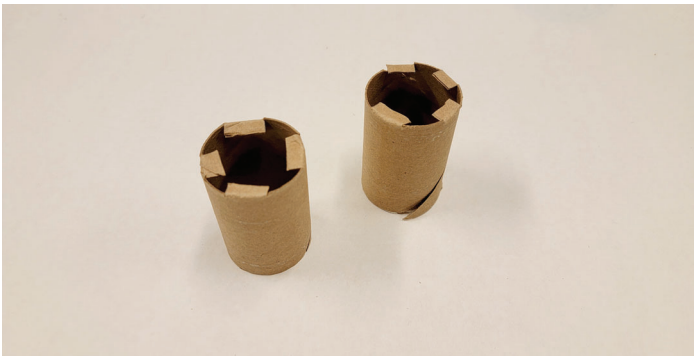
4. Use the 5- by 7-inch cardboard that you cut out in step 1 and glue it to the rightmost tile to level it.



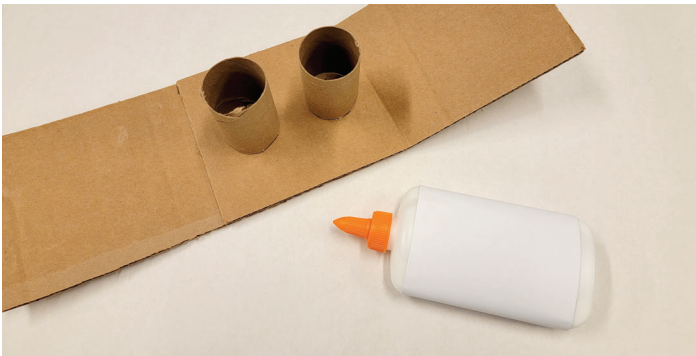
5. Cut two 3-inch-tall pieces from a paper roll.



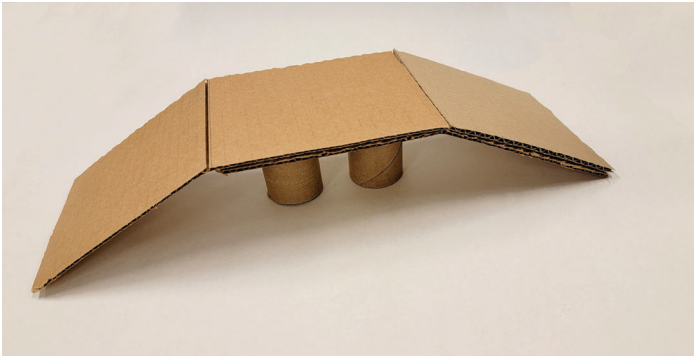
6. Measure and cut 1/2-inch slits into the 3-inch paper roll. Cut away sections to leave at least four flaps.



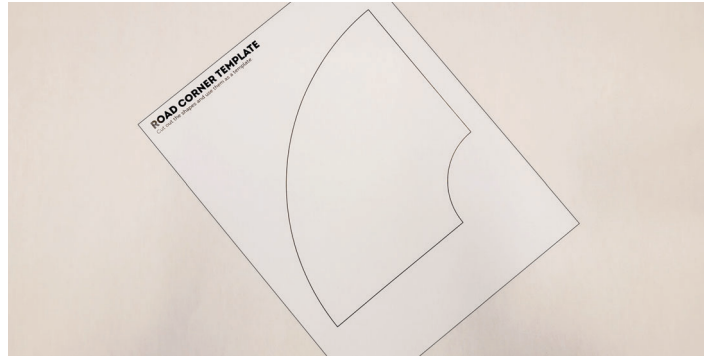
7. Fold down the flaps.



8. Glue the 3-inch paper rolls to the middle section of your bridge.



9. Flip it over and your bridge is done.



10. Print out the provided template of the road piece (page 10) and cut it out.



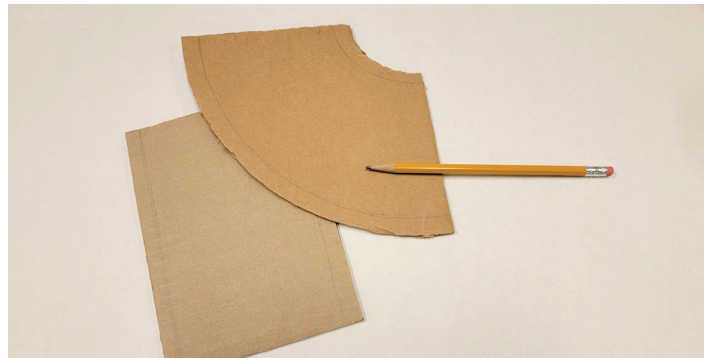
11. Lay the template on a piece of cardboard and trace around it with a pencil.



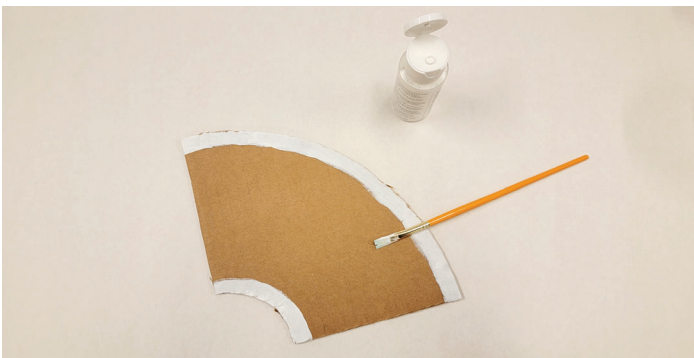
12. Cut out the cardboard shape.



13. Measure a 5- by 7-inch piece of cardboard, and cut it out.



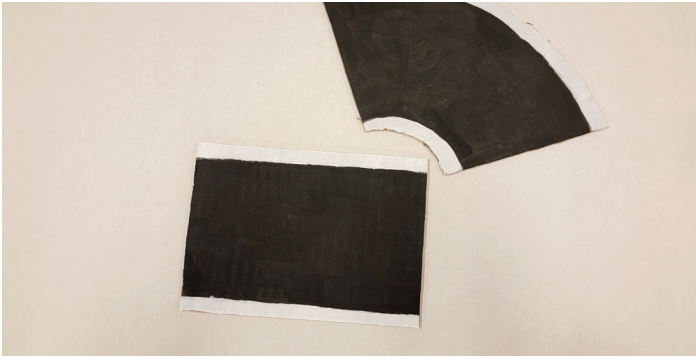
14. Sketch 1/2-inch lines from the edge of your cutout shape to indicate the solid white lines on a road.



15. Paint the smaller sections in white. You don't have to be too precise in this step.



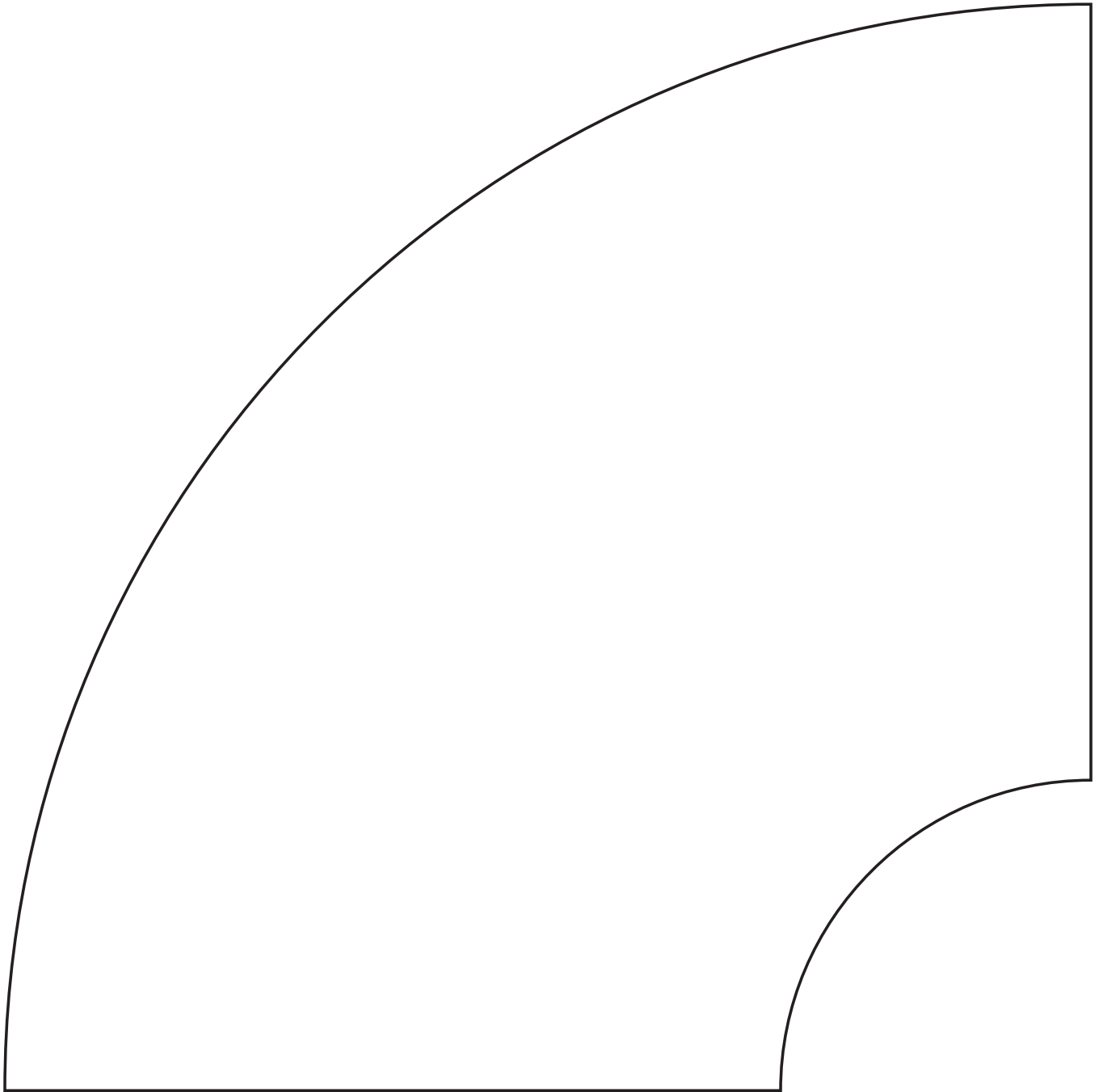
16. Paint the middle section with black paint.



17. Let the paint dry. Create as many road pieces as you like by following the steps above.

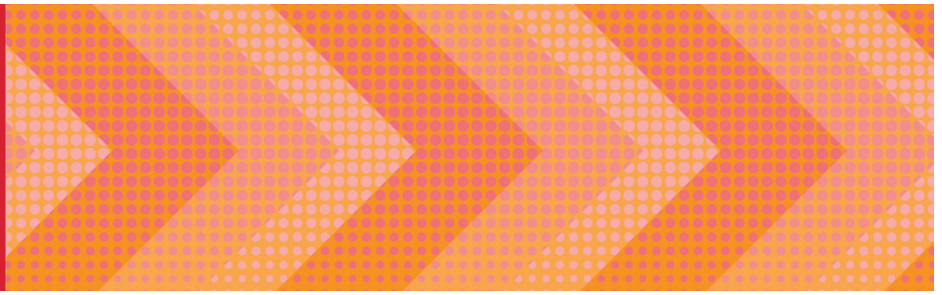
ROAD CORNER TEMPLATE

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ROAD SIGNS

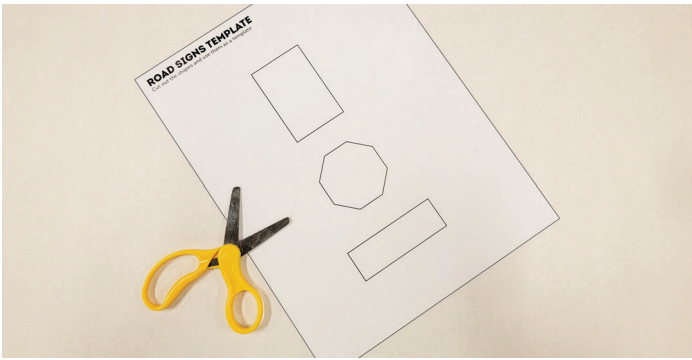
WHAT YOU'LL NEED:

- Non-toxic children's dough
- Craft sticks
- Pencil
- Road signs template

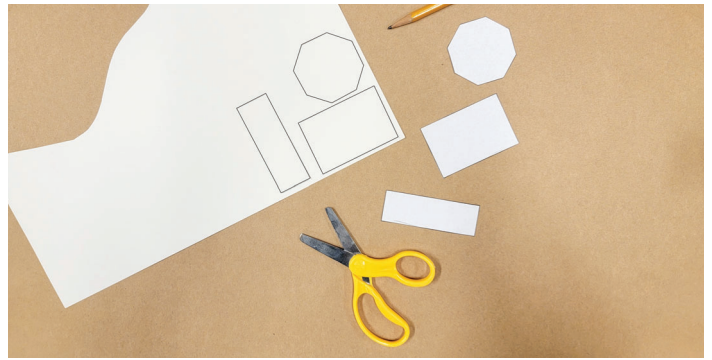


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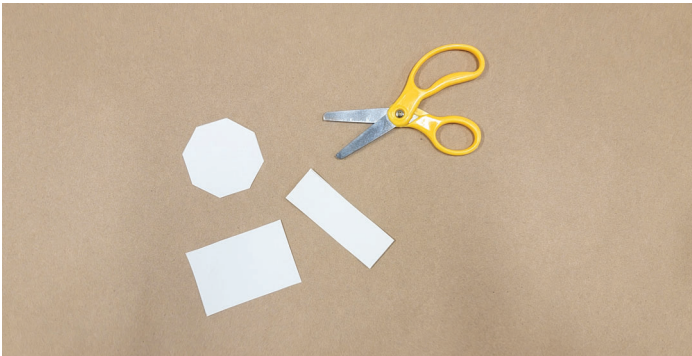




1. Print the road signs template provided with the activities for home (page 13).



2. Cut out the shapes from the template and trace them on top of white construction paper.



3. Cut out the traced shapes.



4. Sketch out the graphics on your road signs.



5. Trace and color them in with a marker.



6. Glue each road sign to a craft stick.



7. Secure each road sign in a ball of craft dough.
